

Briefs: Camptonville seeks funds for center study

A Camptonville partnership is seeking funds from the Sierra Nevada Conservancy for a study into the feasibility of developing a business biomass center.

Yuba County supervisors on Tuesday unanimously supported a request by the Camptonville Community Partnership for support in its application for the funding. The plan would be to create a biomass center to convert small-diameter timber into energy.

The Camptonville Community Partnership has developed community health and family support programs in the foothills community. It is also the fiscal agent for the Yuba Watershed Protection & Fire Safe Council, which has proposed the biomass facility.
